

REGULATIONS FOR THE 2025 **GAS** EXAMINATION

1. Appropriate sitting arrangement should reflect the distance between candidates.
2. Candidates are expected to arrive at the venue of the examination by 9.00am for documentation and screening.
3. The examination commences at **12.00noon** in all the centres.
4. Candidates must sign the Examination Attendance sheet with the Supervisor as evidence to show that the examination was written.
5. Mobile phones and other means of telecommunication are not allowed into the examination hall.
6. Candidates are to come to the venue of the examination with the following items:
 - a. Valid Identity Card or any other means of identification
 - b. Electronic Calculator
 - c. Printout of online GAS application form (not compulsory if your name already appeared on the list uploaded on NIAS the website)
 - d. Writing material – Pen
7. All other normal examination regulations and conditions shall apply.

Note:

- **The examination is going to be Pen and Paper format with Multiple choice questions**
- **Mobile phones, textbooks, prepared materials, programmable calculators, or any other devices that may give a candidate an undue advantage are not permitted in the examination hall.**
- **Candidates should note their examination numbers (code)**
- **Candidates are requested to remain in their seats until officially released.**
